ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The deadline for receipt of abstracts **is March 31st 2010.** No abstracts will be accepted after this date.

Abstracts are encouraged on all aspects of neurotraumatology.

General Information

Method of submission. The only method of submission for abstracts is at our web-site. Abstracts submitted via fax or e-mail will not be accepted. Upon receipt of an abstract each delegate will get a confirmation letter.

Number of abstracts: The number of abstracts from the first author is no more than two.

Language: Abstracts should be submitted and presented in English.

Abstract structure and size: Abstracts should be structured using the following headings: objective, material and methods, results and/or conclusion. The abstract text may not be longer than 1'800 characters, including spaces. Authors should indicate their presentation preference: oral presentation, poster or publication only, and one of main topics.

TYPES OF PRESENTATION

Oral presentation.

Every delegate will be given 10 minutes for oral presentation at a Subject Session.

Poster presentation.

Poster size is 110 cm (vertical) X 70 cm (horizontal).

Poster structure: Title, names, institution, country and city should be indicated in the upper poster part.

Publication.

All abstracts approved by the International Programme Committee will be published in a Book of Abstracts.

- Abstracts must be prepared in English.
- Abstracts previously submitted for publication or submitted, accepted or presented at other neurosurgical and/or medical meetings will not be accepted.
- Please ensure that your e-mail address is accurate at the time of submission. All correspondence will be sent via e-mail to the first author. Should the first author's e-mail address change after the submission deadline, please notify it at icran2010@nsi.ru to update this information.
- All presenters of selected abstracts are required to register and pay the appropriate registration fees for the corresponding meeting.
- Abstracts will only be accepted electronically via the abstract submission site.
- Abstracts should be proofread prior to submission, as in many cases they are published as submitted.
- Abstract data cannot be altered after the abstract center has closed.
- Oral abstract presenters will be required to either upload their presentation or submit their presentation on a CD six hours prior to the start of the session in the Speaker Ready Room.
- The type of presentation (oral or poster) choice selected during the submission process is a request only. The accepted format is at the discretion of the Scientific Program Committee.
